The Mosaic computer labs are intended for students to pursue academic endeavors in a comfortable, productive working environment.

Public display of obscene images is illegal in the State of North Carolina (the specific Obscenity Laws are available in S220).

As a matter of practical enforcement we will take the following actions:

- Any person that finds an image "disturbing" or feels uncomfortable may report the occurrence via email to 'mlc', indicating the workstation number and the time. We can verify the person and the activities by that information alone.
- Persons identified as causing a problem will have their passwords changed and will have to explain their activities in order to regain access to their account.
- Persons continuing to violate this rule will be taken to student court and we will pursue suspension from the College of Engineering and the University.

We ask that you cooperate in this matter and be considerate of your fellow students and their academic pursuits.
